Ultimately, this synthesis reflects the true nature of our existence as an elysium of distorted harmony.

In his painting titled *Muserock*, Leon portrays a sensually posed female figure seemingly camou flaging with the rocks, her hair flows in the breeze. The cityscape details in the background evoke a sense of freedom and an escape from the confines of urban life. *The Lover's Path* presents striking imagery of a man and woman in a dynamic display of intertwining bodies, presenting a passionate dance of union and thought-provoking allegory of the non linear journey of love. In the emotionally charged painting titled *In The Middle*, a vespertine scene unfolds: a beautiful red-haired woman dressed in blue leans against a pink sofa, where a black cat lounges. In the background a crescent moon hangs amidst skyscrapers, symbolizing womanhood in a mans world. The figure's body language alludes to an inner reflection of emotional tumult, suggesting complications in the complex realm of romantic relationships. In *The Soul Improviser*, a neoteric image of a woman contorting her body around a distorted guitar fused with her anatomy, reminds us to embrace spontaneity in a world that oftentimes makes us feel trapped, ultimately diminishing the inner music that is our spirit we must keep alive.

About Darwin Leon

Darwin Leon was born in 1972 in Santiago de las Vegas a small town in Havana, Cuba. In 1987, Leon's family sought refuge from the political and economic crisis in Cuba, and departed to Spain, then later continued to the united States to settle in Miami, FL. Leon earned his Bachelors in Fine Arts from Miami International University of Art & Design, where he attended as a recipient of the 'Visual Arts Scholarship Award of Excellence' and received Best in Show at his first Juried Student Exhibition. His first direction was expressed through religious portraits. However, he found greater enthusiasm for figurative and expressionistic forms in which he incorporated satire and irony through surrealism and cubism. Leon's work is energetic, fresh, alive and abundant with color.

Leon's art combines aspects of the masters of the Renaissance, including the technique of chiaroscuro, with his own surreal style, which he refers to as Expressionistic Surrealism. Scenic images portray the nature of expressive deign through the movement of action and textured aspects. With a sharp sense of humor and figurative imagination, Darwin Leon details the social context of pseudo-political, human involvement with a gift for enhanced form and characterization. Displaying the imbalances of society with satirical perspective, his artistic creations animate the discontinuities of the past industrial order. Leon's paintings play on the interpersonal deceptions that move a society.
